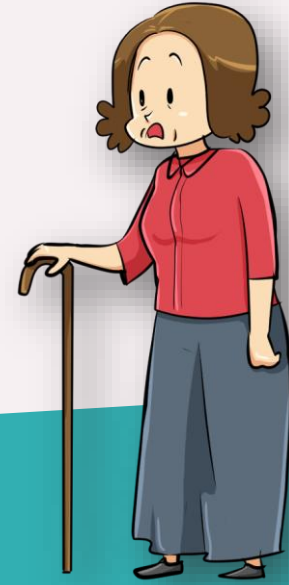


A Church Full of Differences
