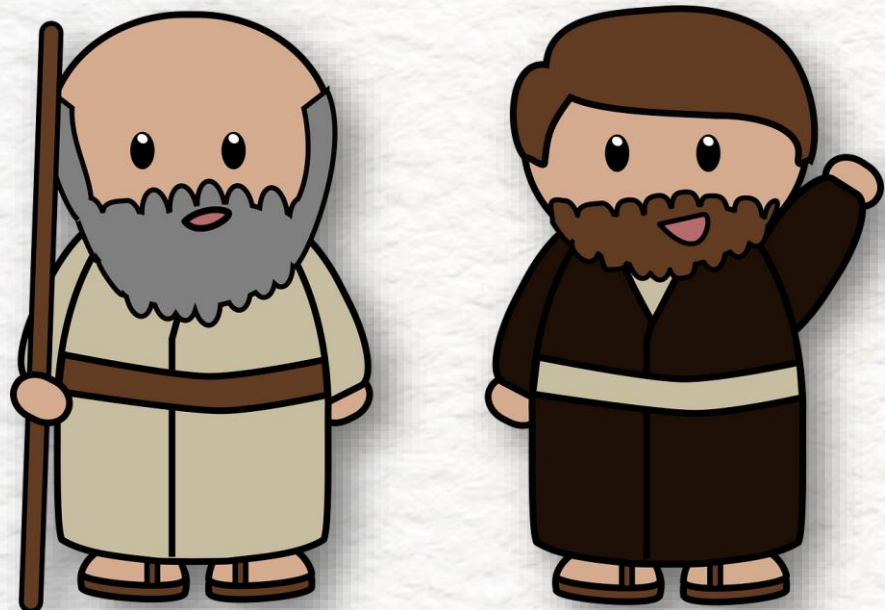




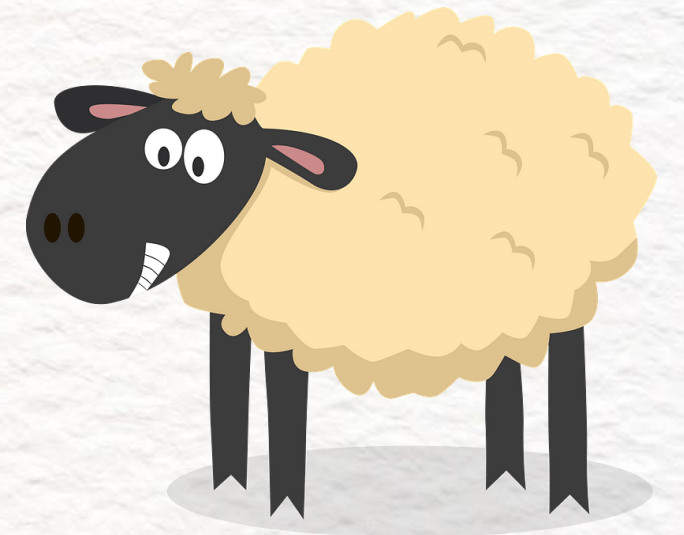
# Generosity
