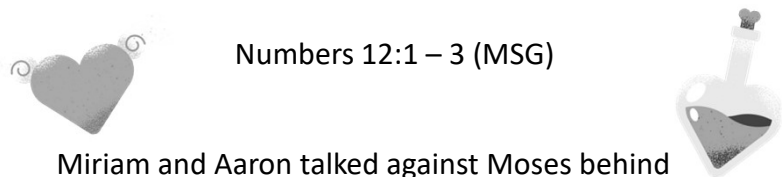


Avoiding a Critical Heart
