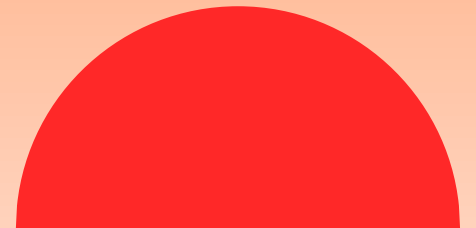
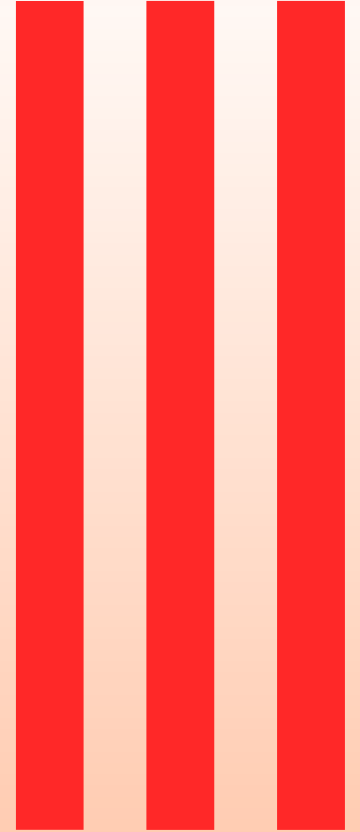


Serving God
