Discuss

- What words does this passage use to describe God's Word?
- What do those descriptions teach us about the Bible?
- Verse 7 says that God's instruction is "perfect" and "refreshes the soul." How can God's Word bring encouragement or strength when someone is having a difficult day?
- What is the difference between merely reading the Bible and listening to what God is saying through it?
- What is one area of life—friendships, school, work, money, emotions, entertainment, or something else—where you need God's wisdom?

- Thank God that you have His communication to you, the Bible.
- Ask God to help your family understand what you read in His Word.
- Pray that you will learn to trust what you learn in the Scripture and apply it to your lives.
- Ask the Lord to help you make it a daily habit to read and think carefully about what He is saying to you.
