# Consider this passage

Matthew 12:31-32 (NLT2) “Every sin and blasphemy can be forgiven—except blasphemy against the Holy Spirit, which will never be forgiven. 32 Anyone who speaks against the Son of Man can be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven, either in this world or in the world to come.

# Note

- One of the tasks of God's Holy Spirit is to use Scripture to convict us or convince us of our sinful condition and of ways in which we have disobeyed God – that is, our sins.
