Discuss

 What did Elisha's servant see and what feeling did it generate within him?



- Why is human perception of spiritual realities often limited?
- We might say Elisha's servant "freaked out." How do we often respond similarly when we face overwhelming situations?
- What actions can we take to have "open eyes" to see
 God's provision and protection in those circumstances?

Pray

- Praise the Lord for protecting you when overcome with people or situations confronting us.
- Tell God about struggles you are in right now that you don't see any good solutions.
- Declare to Him that you are believing that His "army" of protection is present, even if you don't see it.
- Like Elisha, pray for others you know who are feeling exhausted and have yet to experience deliverance by God's power.
