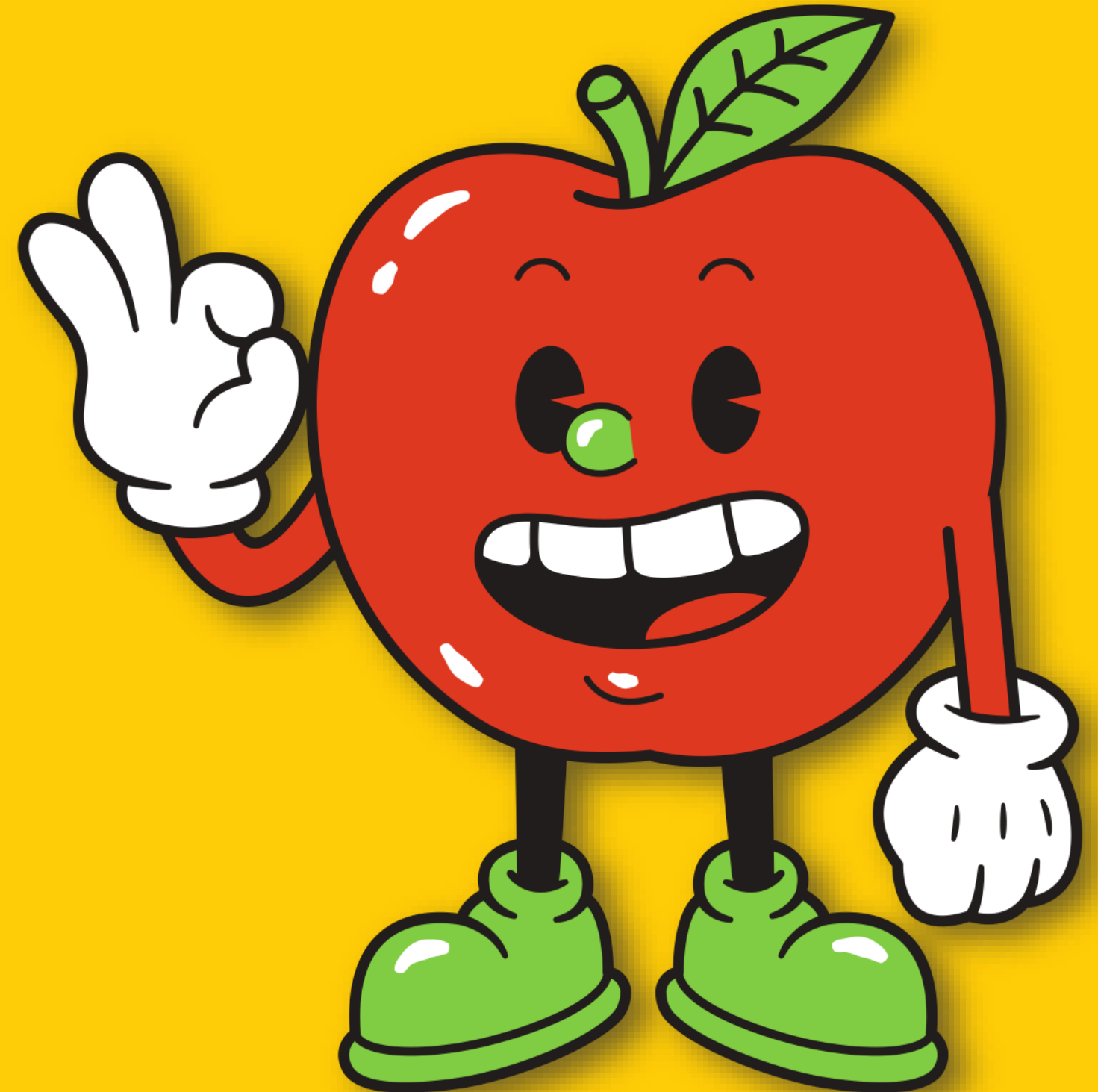




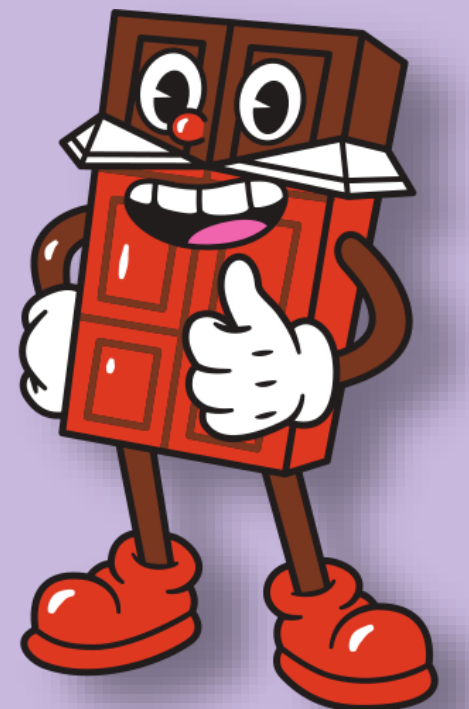
Who Got an Award?
