
SPACE FOR NOTES

The High Priest and his associates became very jealous of the popularity of the Apostles. So they had them arrested and put in prison.

During the night an angel of the Lord opened the doors of the prison and let them out. 'Go into the Temple courts,' the angel instructed, 'and tell the people all about this new life.'




