


Small Seed Big Plant




Discuss



- What are some plants where the seed is very small compared to the size of the plant?
- Jesus compared “small faith” to the small seed that grows into something big. How might a small act of kindness or prayer of “small faith” grow into something much bigger?
- How do you think God uses the “small faith” of our prayers to make a big difference?
- How can we encourage each other to keep praying, even if our “faith seed” feels small right now?



Prayer

- Think of some specific things you prayed for and God answered the prayer. Thank Him for working in a big way even though you might have had "small faith".
- Now think of some big "mountains" that you have where only God can move them and meet your need. Tell God you maybe have only "small faith", but you are believing He is a "Big God" and you are trusting Him to act in a powerful way.
- Maybe you know someone who needs to ask Jesus into their life, but that person has no desire to become a believer. There is a big "mountain" that God can move. Pray with your "small faith" to move that person to come to Jesus.
- Ask God to help you to plant small seeds of faith and kindness each day this coming week.
