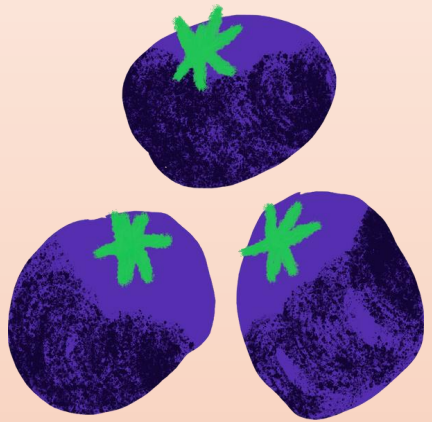
Family Discussion

Blessed are you who run to him.

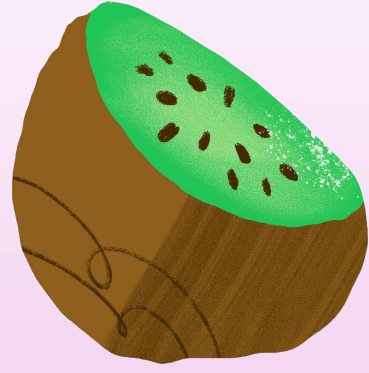
Worship God if you want the best;

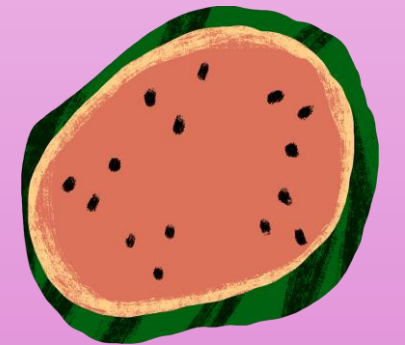




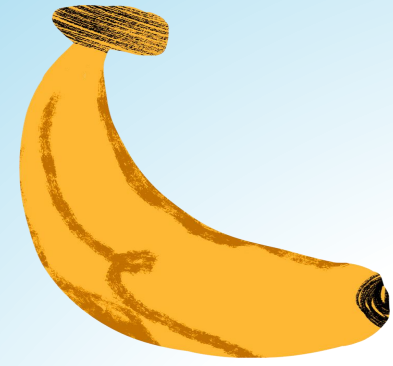
Discuss
